The venue is at Stockholm University Campus

Thursday the 11th November the workshop is in the Geoscience Building (Geovetenskapens hus - marked with X on the map). The rooms for the workshop are located on the third floor, just up the large stairs in the entrance. The names of the rooms are Nordenskiöld, and two side rooms U37 and U36.

Friday the 12th November the workshop is in the Southern House at the Campus (Södra Huset – marked with an O on the map). Rooms E306 and E319.

How to get to the Stockholm University Campus

The workshop will be held at Stockholm University campus. The best option to get there is by Metro **red line 14** towards **Mörby centrum**. Get off at the station **Universitetet** (University).

Transport from Arlanda Airport to Stockholm City

You can take the Arlanda Express (train) to Stockholm City. It takes only 20 minutes and costs 240SEK (24 EURO) one way. The train will take you to Stockholm Central Station where you can take the metro to your hotel.

A cheaper alternative to travel from Arlanda airport to Stockholm City is to take a bus. The bus ride takes between 30 and 45 minutes and costs 99SEK if you buy the ticket on Internet, or 119SEK if you buy it on the bus (no cash, only MasterCard, VISA, Amex and Diners). The bus takes you to Stockholm Central Station where you can take the metro to your hotel.

Public transport in Stockholm

Stockholm has very good public transport. SL (Stockholm Public Transport) is a convenient way to travel when exploring the capital of Sweden. It takes less time than taking taxi, is cheaper and environmentally-friendly.

You can buy tickets to the metro at the metro station or at *Pressbyrån*.

One way ticket costs 30SEK.

It might pay off to by a pre-paid strip for 180 SEK, which contains 8 travels. It gives you a discount, each travel equals 22,5 SEK.

How to get to the hotel

If you are staying at the recommended hotel, Clarion Collection Hotel Tapto

Take the Metro **red line 14** towards **Mörby centrum** and get off at the station called **Stadion**. It is a four minute walk from the metro station to the hotel.
