### INFOBASE supports the EU adaptation strategy

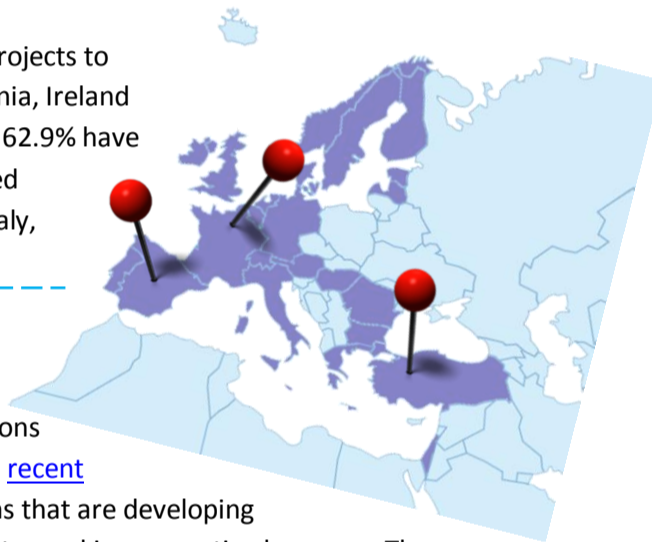
