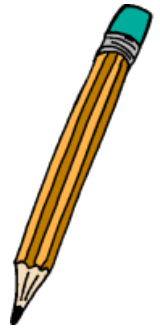


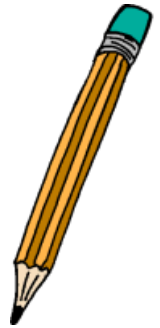
## Conclusion from the workshop discussion

- ◆ Need to focus on the processes. How to organize the process to learn more about user needs.
- ◆ Suggested working title of a scoping workshop: **“Process to engage with users to develop good adaptation”**.



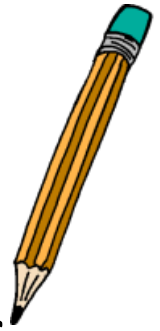
## Conclusion from the workshop discussion

- ◆ The scoping work-shop could be jointly organized by JPI Climate and CIRCLE-2.
- ◆ It should cover experiences from different countries ( UK, Germany, Netherlands etc).
- ◆ The Info-base plays an important role as a place to feed in good examples of the outcomes of this scoping workshop.



## Highlights of the discussion:

- ◆ The users differ and so does their user needs, both between sectors and within a sector.
- ◆ One way to approach the user needs, is to start the process of a vision –and inviting the users to discuss a vision of for example 2050, and then define targets. After that it is easier to see the user needs.



## Highlights of the discussion:

- ◆ We need to decide which users to approach. Probably it is wise to focus on a sector. We also talked about bringing the intermediate persons together – those who today are working in establishing constructive stakeholder dialogues.



## Highlights of the discussion:

◆ We talked about the general need of users engagement, in a broader sense than (wider than CIRCLE2 and task 4.2). For example dialogues within specific sectors, a series of workshops to gain knowledge and information from users. The scoping workshop could help in clarify this need, by exchanging experiences + giving guidelines on methods.
